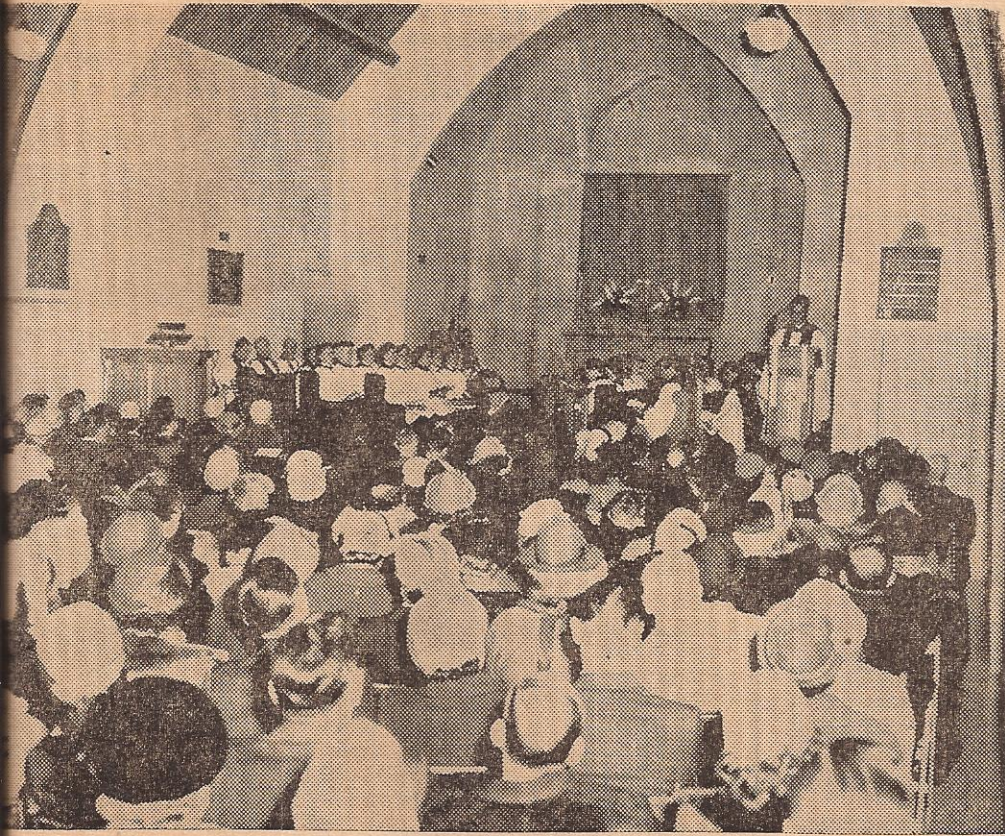


ST. MARK'S CHURCH, CALGARY



A Sixty Thousand Dollar Calgary Church

A new St. Mark's Church, Calgary, costing \$60,000, was dedicated by the Right Reverend G. R. Calvert. It will replace the old church built forty-three years ago.

The new church is the only one in Calgary, and believed to be the only one in Alberta, with such a roof construction. The beams and arches were imported from the U.S. and make it possible for the whole church to have no supporting cross arms.

Of polished walnut-colored wood, the high arched ceiling slopes to grey, rough, finished walls containing a sound-absorbing material. The church will seat about 500 persons.

The Rector is the Reverend W. E. Askey, the assistant is the Reverend C. M. Starr and the chairman of the building committee is Mr. Austin Ford.
