

Important Dates in the History of St Mark's Church

- 1912 – St Mark's dedicated by Rt. Rev. Pinkham on October 6**
- 1913 – First Parish meeting on January 26**
- 1915 – First Confirmation Class**
- 1927 – Re-orientation and re-dedication of the church**
- 1934 – First Christmas Eve Midnight Eucharist**
- 1937 – 25th Anniversary**
- 1951 – it was decided to build a new church building**
- 1952 – Bishop Calvert turns the sod for the new building**
- 1953 – New building is dedicated by Bishop Calvert on March 31**
Cornerstone is laid by Bishop Calvert on September 19
- 1957 – Pipe Organ purchased from St. Augustine, Lethbridge**
- 1960 – Archdeacon Axon turns the sod for the new hall on May 15**
New hall dedicated on October 23
- 1961 – Sanctuary Stained Glass dedicated on June 18**
- 1962 – 50th Anniversary**
- 1963 – Baptistry windows donated**
- 1967 – Bishop Calvert consecrated the church on April 23**
- 1971 – Parish Hall mortgage burned**

1972 – 60th Anniversary dinner

1977 – New Processional Cross blessed

1980 – New tabernacle, vestments, altar superfrontals, carpeting dedicated

1981 – New carpet in Nave

1987 – 75th Anniversary, new Church doors

1993 – New handicapped elevator installed

1997 – Carillon installed

1998 – New kitchen, cork flooring and steeple installed and dedicated

2002 – 90th Anniversary celebration on October 6

2006 – St Mark and St Philip church was formed from the amalgamation of St Mark's Church and St Philip the Evangelist church. Parishioners are worshipping on the St Mark's church site.

2012 – 100th Anniversary celebration of an Anglican presence in the Marda Loop community of Calgary, on October 13 and 14
